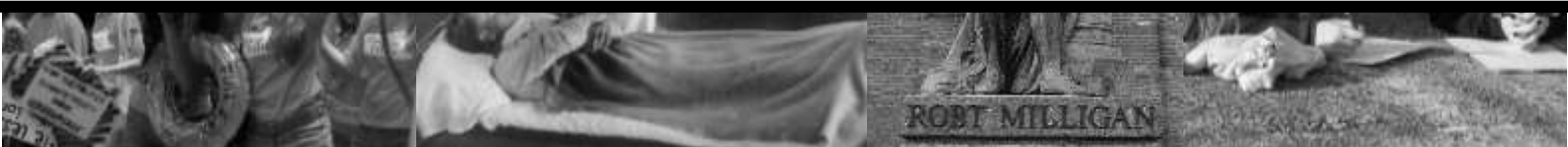




VIRTUAL HEIRNET CONFERENCE 2021
